



Kenai Peninsula Borough School District **COVID-19 POSITIVE** Monitor, Mask and Return Protocol

Monitor. Mask. Return to school or work.

Staff and students who test positive for COVID-19 and have not experienced any symptoms of illness may choose to end isolation and return to work or school on Day 6. Staff and students must follow the KPBSD Monitor, Mask and Return Protocols to return to school or work.



SYMPTOM FREE Day 0-6

After a positive COVID-19 test, continue to be symptom free from illness (asymptomatic) Days 0-5. The first day of a positive COVID-19 test is Day 0.

If any symptoms of illness begin to develop on days 6-10, you must stay home and the 5-day isolation should start over.

FACE COVERINGS

Wear a well-fitted face covering in school at all times on Days 6 -10.

If any symptoms of illness develop, you must stay home and isolate. When you cannot wear a face covering (i.e., when eating or drinking) you should maintain a minimum of six feet of distance from other individuals to every extent possible.

RETURN to School Days 6-10

If you have never experienced COVID-19 symptoms, on Day 6 you may return to work or school, and strictly follow the Monitor, Mask and Return protocol.

Athletes: In addition, to continue to participate in school sponsored co-curricular activities athletes must also continue Daily Symptom Check Protocols

Do you have symptoms and a positive COVID-19 test?

People who have COVID-19 and have or had symptoms may return to school or work ten days after their positive COVID-19 test or symptom onset date. They must be fever-free for 24 hours without the use of fever-reducing medication.

KPBSD is continuing to work with public health and may make revisions to this protocol in the next few weeks.
